

Report from the meeting Sura Mica, Romania 24th - 30th April 2017

Dates for the meeting in Rome, Italy:

Wednesday 8th November - Sunday 12th November (Programme 9th-11th, travel days 8th and 12th November)

History - Time Witnesses:

About 115 Time Witness interviews have been done in different partner countries. Italy and Sweden have published some of the interviews on Wikispaces, **the other countries have to publish their on 15th May at the latest.**

All countries have to comment each other's work before the summer holidays. Note that you could write comments in your own language, since our project is multilingual!

The students taking part in the meeting presented their interviews in small group, which was very appreciated.

During our stay teachers in our project and also people from the local community shared their life stories, which gave us a chance of deeper reflection and understanding.

In the Astra museum of Traditional Folk Civilization both students and teachers participated in interactive activities in History.

Mathematics:

During the meeting the students worked with some assignments linked to the price comparison, a task they have prepared at home. **Romania will publish the results of the work at the meeting on Wikispaces in the form of graphics. All countries should then use the graphics and comment before the summer holidays.**

Concerning the assignment "Understanding calculations without a calculator" only Poland and Sweden have published their results on Wikispaces. **The other countries have to publish theirs on 15th May at the latest and all partner countries have to comment before the summer holidays.**

In the Astra museum of Traditional Folk Civilization the students participated in interactive activities in mathematics.

Wikispaces:

The use of Wikispaces has been more difficult than we expected. One complication is that our students can only belong to one team, so therefore we have let them use our log-ins, the teachers, in order to be able to see more of the work on the platform and to be able to comment on the work of other teams.

We decided to **publish as much as possible on Wikispaces**; it doesn't have to be long essays and it doesn't have to be in English, as long as the material concerns history or mathematics. If you write in your own language the students at your school or in your country could easily use it and comment.

Trauma:

Every partnerschool has shared examples of good practices, they were added to the brochure "Trauma and School". The brochure is translated into Romanian, Swedish and English. Italy, Spain and Poland have not finished their translation but they are working on it. The brochure has been printed in German, Romanian and English and will soon be printed in Swedish.

After the translation all partners will publish the brochure on the website of their schools. We will all send the translations to Marianne for her to publish them on www.yestermorrow.eu

Concerning "Lily, Ben and Omid", translations from the German original has been made into English, Romanian, Swedish and Arabic. From May the book will also be available in French, Farsi and Tigrinja. In Poland, Spain and Italy the book will be produced as audiobook/podcast.

The work with "A Safe Place" goes on in every partner country. In Romania and Sweden Marianne has held her lecture about trauma. The books "Lily, Ben and Omid" have been spread. Due to the big success of the picture book a 2nd edition in Romanian has been printed. The book is disseminated to other institutions in Romania, e.g. to a counseling center for victims of domestic violence, a rehab center for addicted people, a home for the children a.s.o. Sweden will try to organize another with Marianne in spring 2018, for the teachers and preschool-teachers and has tried the book with both younger and older students with good results.. In Italy the a video about the topic has been made and the project has been presented during the "Vocational Skills Week". Poland has introduced the book at a conference. England has used the book and brochure in counselling teams, in the work with students with special needs and as help for refugee families.

If you see anything concerning trauma, please send it to Marianne. She will publish it on the blog on the website. Remember that there is a lot of interesting information on the website, which could be used among your students!

Ideas for the third year:

We decided to keep the same questions but to stretch the period from the Second World War to present time. If you have new students you could work in the same way as this year or you could choose to use the material on the Wikispaces in order to compare with another time period or other countries.

Dissemination:

It is very **important to disseminate** our learning activities, the book and the brochure. Try to find activities where the students have to look at the website and spread the address of it! Report to local media when you have activities of common interest.
